

PlaNNet Finance partnership



Presentation

At the end of 2006, Accor and PlaNNet Finance signed a two-year partnership agreement for two different projects in Morocco.

The first project aims in integration of disadvantaged young people into working life, and the second one enable the support for argan oil cooperatives.

Implementation and results

Integration of disadvantaged young people into working life

The first project was designed to integrate 100 young people from deprived areas of Casablanca and Tangiers into the labor market, teaching them how to go into business for themselves or preparing them for employment.



These young people, all aged between 16 and 25, received personal careers advice and over a period of 18 months attended a three-part training course on:

1. Their rights and responsibilities as citizens
2. Life skills: employability and business awareness
3. Knowledge of micro credit, information technology and micro enterprise management

Support for argan oil cooperatives

The second project was aimed at supporting the development of several women's cooperatives producing argan oil in the Essaouira region.

In total, four cooperatives gathering 100 women were contacted by PlaNNet Finance and Accor. They received support to:

1. Help protect the region's argan trees
2. Find out more about the social rights of women in cooperatives
3. Learn about information technology and marketing
4. Access new marketing networks
5. Use their argan oil production to diversify into ecotourism
